Products

Excess

Excess applies once per person admitted per calendar year for all hospital products except AC2, AC3, AS1, AS2, AS3, EC2, EC3, SC2, SC3, SG2, SG3, TC2, TC3.

Excess is waived for Dependents <31 years of age insured under a family/single parent family/single parent family plus membership on all product offerings throughout the calendar year.

The excess is payable per person each calendar year. If the total excess is not paid after the first hospital admission, the remaining balance of the excess must be paid on any subsequent admissions within the same calendar year for products AC2, AC3, AS1, AS2, AS3, EC2, EC3, SC2, SG2, SG3, TC2, TC3.

The excess is halved for day surgery and waived for Dependents <31 years of age on products AC2, AC3, AS1, AS2, AS3, EC2, EC3, KZ2, KZ3, KS2, KS3, K42, K43, SC2, SC3, SG2, SG3, TC2, TC3.

Excess waiver for Day only admissions for the following products: LB, SME

Excess waiver for Accident related admissions for the following products AH2, AH3, BA, BA2, B2, DH2, DH3, LB, YH2, YH3, YC3, YC4 - see Accident notes for more details.

Ce-payments

For products where a patient co-payment is shown, the member payment applies to all overnight accommodation in hospital.

\$13 per night (capped at \$75 per admission) payable for the following products H1, K3, L3, J1 waived for public hospitals and same day admissions.

\$55 per night (capped at \$275 per admission) payable for the following products H2, K2, L2, J2 waived for public hospitals and same day admissions.

\$50 per night (capped at \$250 per admission) payable for the following products VHE, VHI waived for Dependents <31 and same day admissions.

\$100 per night (capped at \$300 per admission) payable for the following products VHE, VHI, PH2, PH3, CG3 waived for Dependents <31

Accident

Accident means an unplanned and unforeseen event, covering by chance, and leading to bodily injuries caused solely and directly by an external force or object requiring treatment from a Medical Practitioner (defined here as a medical doctor who is not the member or a relative of the Member) within 7 days of the event, but excludes injuries arising out of: surgical procedures; unknown illness; pregnancy; drug use; and aggravation of an underlying condition or injury.

Accident cover

The following products covers Private Hospital admissions in the event of an accident AC2, AC3, AH2, AH3, AS1, AS2, AS3, BA, BA2, B2, CH2, CH3, DH2, DH3, H1H, H1H2, K3H, K3H2, KZ3, KS2, KS3, K42, K43, LB, MH2, MH3, SC2, SC3, SG2, SG3, SH2, SH3, SME, TC2, TC3, TH2, TH3, TPI, TPI2, TPI3, VHE2, VHE3, YH2, YH3, YHI2, YHI3, YC2, YC3.

Where a hospital cover offers this benefit, to be eligible, the accident must have occurred after the member has joined the level of cover and has sought medical attention from a registered medical practitioner within seven (7) days of the event. The provision of this benefit is at our discretion; we will ask for the completion of an accident declaration and the member's doctor to complete a medical report.

Exclusions and restrictions

For Australian Unity's health cover products please refer to the below table.

Product VHE, VHI (Single Hospital Inpatient) and YC3, YC4 (Single-Sever, Share (-)). Only covers Tumours, Adenoids & Gynaecology, Joint Reconstructions, Hernia & Appendicitis and Dental Surgery and treatment required as a result of an Accident in Private Hospital.

Product LB only covers treatment at the minimum default benefit as set by the Commonwealth Government (MCOB).

Product LB only covers non excluded treatments if a day stay, otherwise is restricted.

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
